Bilborough College is a member of Better Futures Multi Academy Trust (BFMAT). Each college which makes up BFMAT has its own Local Governing Body of 14 governors. The role of the Local Governing Bodies is to govern the colleges on behalf of the Trust Board and to provide information to the Trust Board on the performance of the individual colleges.

The Local Governing Body is expected to perform functions such as setting the strategic direction for the college, holding the Principal and Senior Leadership Team to account and monitoring educational and financial performance. Internal matters regarding course organisation, academic standards and student welfare are the responsibility of the Principal.

The Local Governing Body meets six times a year and meetings take place on a Monday evening commencing at 5pm.

As a governor your experience, insight and ideas will widen the perspective of our Governing Body. At the moment we're particularly keen to hear from accountants, auditors, finance directors, lawyers, entrepreneurs and company directors with business and financial skills.
