#### 3. Thinking/brainstorm task:

- We will be starting with the Globalisation topic. Have a think about the first enquiry question below, write it onto the middle of a piece of paper and brainstorm/mind map some ideas you can think of to answer this question from your GCSE learning and own research/thoughts.
  - Enquiry question 1: What are the causes of globalisation and why has it accelerated in recent decades?
- If you have time, then you might like to take a similar approach to the other 2 enquiry questions in the course below – a great way to work out what you already know!
  - Enquiry question 2: What are the impacts of globalisation for countries, different groups of people and cultures and the physical environment?
  - Enquiry question 3: What are the consequences of globalisation for global development and the physical environment and how should different players respond to its challenges?

#### 4. Setting up you Geography folder and equipment:

- You will need to set up a new folder for Geography with file dividers if you can get them and be ready to learn.
- You will also need pens, pencil, ruler, calculator and highlighters if you can arrange these or dig them out of your old bag!
