How to buy a digital bus pass

The college does not issue plastic bus passes. Instead, students have a pass on their smartphone. Passes are managed by Skills Motor Coaches using an online platform or app.

For every journey:

- Students must be wearing their college lanyard and ID
- Students must scan their digital pass on the driver's device to board the bus

Passes can only be purchased online, either using the **Search my Coach** app or the booking link provided below. If you need a bus pass, you are strongly advised to purchase one as soon as possible.

The Skills app **Search My Coach** or the online portal stores your pass to be scanned by the driver and this lets you track the service to keep you up to date on journey times.

Zones and Pricing 2023 - 2024

New students who need a pass are encouraged to apply when they enrol at the college. The college provides a discount of approximately 10% for payment in full made at enrolment or by the start of term. Alternatively, payments can be made in three monthly instalments if this is more convenient as set out below. The initial payment will be made online by credit or debit card and the instalments will be collected automatically when due.

Students receiving a college bursary (household incomes of £29,000 or less) are usually provided with a pass as part of their bursary entitlement (more information <u>www.bilborough.ac.uk</u>) full details provided at enrolment.

Routes are zoned by distance and travelling time and priced accordingly. A pass covers morning and afternoon journeys to / from college for the full academic year (term time only) including all study leave and exam periods.

These prices are for a place on the bus for a full academic year and refunds are not available. All the prices below have been heavily subsidised by the college.

Students wishing to use the bus occasionally may purchase day tickets online (from $\pounds 3.00 - \pounds 6.50$) subject to availability, as annual pass holders take priority. Tickets must be purchased before boarding the bus and tickets must be scanned by the driver.

***Discounted prices for full payment by the start of term.** Prices are reviewed on an annual basis and new prices apply from August each year. Year 12 students progressing into Year 13 may purchase a pass for a second year at the same price by buying a new pass before annual price increases are applied. Students are notified how to do this at the end of Year 12.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR USE OF THE COLLEGE TRANSPORT SERVICE

By using the college bus service, all passengers are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

Students must scan their pass for every journey and wear their college lanyard with ID so that the driver knows you are a Bilborough Student.

Students must arrive at their bus stop at least 5 minutes before the timetabled time and must flag the bus down.

Students are expected to behave respectfully towards the driver, other students and the vehicle. Unacceptable behaviour (this includes loud music, messing around on the bus) could result in disciplinary action and/or withdrawal of the bus pass and payment for the repair of any wilful damage caused.

If you pay for the bus pass in instalments, please be aware that payments must be made by the due date. If you fail to pay an instalment, the full outstanding balance will become payable within 7 days of our demand. Unpaid accounts may be passed to solicitors for debt collection and students will not be permitted to travel on college transport. If you anticipate difficulties in making payments, please contact us as soon as possible.

Please note that whilst you can expect a reliable and friendly service, roadworks, traffic conditions, weather etc. are beyond our control.

If you feel the service has not been satisfactory, please report your concerns to the Main Reception who will liaise with Skills to resolve the issues.

Occasionally it may be necessary to alter routes, pick-up points and timings. As much advance notice as possible will be given, students will be notified via text message and email and details will be updated on the website.

Please note that bus passes are for an academic year, it is not possible to purchase a bus pass for part of the year.
