





- Your exam timetable on Cedar will show the date and time for each your exams
- It will also show the room, your seat number and your candidate number.
- You will need to write your candidate number on your exam papers so please try to remember this!



Arrive at least **15 minutes** before your exam. The invigilator will call you in when they are ready.

If you are running late, please ring college and let us know so we can put arrangements in place.



Your student ID badge is required to enter the exam room - we need to be able to identify you for attendance registers.

Once you are seated for the exam, place your ID card on the desk in front of you so invigilators can see it without disturbing you.

Electronics

Mobile phones must be switched off and placed in your bag. The invigilator will give instructions where bags must be kept. Do not keep it in your pocket.

All watches must be placed in your bag - clocks will be visible to everyone in the exam room.
