Whether you are now looking forward to a well-earned break or preparing for your next steps, we hope you take some time to reflect on everything you have achieved.

Results Day will take place on **Thursday 13 August** in the **Study Zone area**. Your results will be available to collect between **8:00 am** and **3:00 pm**. Your results will also be available on CEDAR and be sent to your Bilborough College email address on the day, so please ensure you can access these platforms. **Please note that, in line with data protection legislation (GDPR), we are unable to give examination results over the telephone to parents, guardians, or any other third party without the student's prior consent.** If you are attending the college to collect your results, support will be available from members of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT), tutors, and the Careers Team should you wish to discuss your results or your next steps.

If you are considering requesting a review of marking, we recommend first checking your raw marks against the relevant grade boundaries, as we will aim to include your raw marks on your results slip where possible. For example, if your raw mark is 165 and the grade boundary for a B is 168, you are only three marks away from the next grade, so a review of marking may be worth considering. However, please be aware that a review can result in your mark staying the same, increasing, or decreasing.

Before requesting a review of marking, we also recommend applying for access to your exam script. This is a free service that allows you to see the examiners marking for each question, helping you make an informed decision about whether a review of marking is appropriate.
